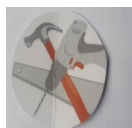

Blessed Stanly Rother: First American born declared Martyr of our Country:

In the April issue of the Knights of Columbus, Columbia Magazine, is an article about Blessed Stably Rother. Stanly Rother was born in Okarche, Oklahoma, and was ordained a priest on May 25, 1963, for the Archdiocese of Oklahoma. In 1968 Father Stanly was assigned to mission work in Santiago Atitlan, Guatemala, and would serve for 13 years until the country's violent civil war reached his remote village where he was murdered in the church rectory on July 28, 1981. He was 46 years old. Father Rother was declared a martyr by Pope Francis in 2016, clearing the way for his beatification, which took place on September 23rd, 2017, in Oklahoma City. On a 53-acre shrine campus with a new Spanish colonial style church, pilgrim center, museum, and shrine hill in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe was dedicated at solemn Mass on February 17th. Blessed Stably Rother is buried inside the Church altar of the Rather Shrine Chapel. Blessed Stanly, pray for us!
