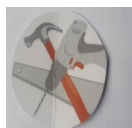

In classical Greek Philosophy there are three transcendentals of all beings: Truth, Goodness and Beauty. There is a harmony or unity that binds them together. Saint Thomas Aquinas, priest and doctor of the Church, expressed how these transcendentals express the reality of God. I have recently read two books that I recommend for those who enjoy science and cosmology. In The Beginning, A Catholic Scientist Explains How God Made the Earth our Home, by Gerard Verschuuren and God’s Grandeur, The Catholic Case for Intelligent Design, edited by Ann Gauger, PH.D. Both are available from SOPHIA Institute Press. These books would be helpful to parents who want to ponder the wonders of God with their children who treasure the field of science. In God’s Grandeur, Chapter 15 by Logan Paul Gage, entitled: “Beauty as Evidence of Intelligent Design,” teaches: The “transcendental properties of being point beyond themselves to the ultimate reality... that our world is the product of intelligent design.” The Hymn: Beautiful Savior, teaches that Beauty saves us and adorns the world with grace. Jesus!

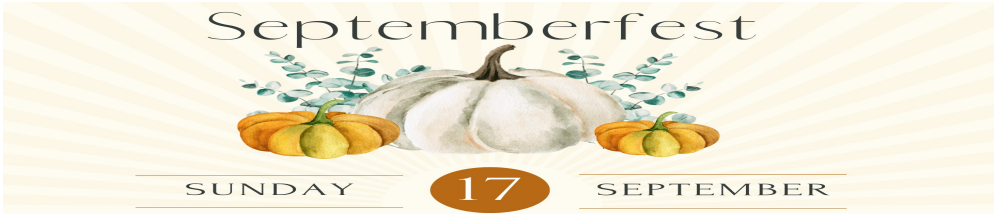
