Saint Margaret of Castello, Feast Day: April 13th

Since April 5th, I have been praying a novena in preparation for the Feast Day of Saint Margaret of Castello, which the Church will celebrate on Saturday, April 15th. Saint Margaret was beatified in 1609 and canonized in 2021 by Pope Francis. Pope Francis mentions the tragedy “of living in a throw away culture.” Our present age casts people aside as insignificant. Saint Margaret of Castello was born blind with dwarfism, nearly unable to walk because of severe scoliosis, causing her parents to hide her from the world, by having her walled-up in a room beside a chapel. Where she received religious instruction until young adulthood. Her parents, hearing of miraculous healings taking place in the town of Citta di Castello, took Margaret there. However, not receiving a healing miracle, her parents abandoned Margaret. The people of Castello cared for Margaret and soon discovered her as a precious treasure that revealed God’s love and mercy. Margaret poured out the love of Christ for others until her death, at the age of 33.

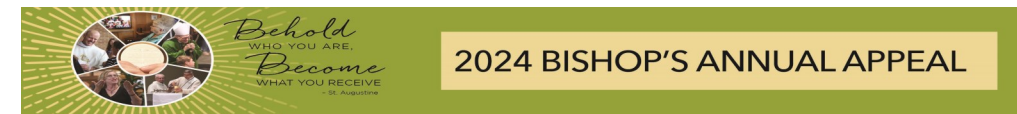
