

Novena to St. Peregrine, Patron Saint of Cancer, begins on April 23rd to May 1st.

Peregrine a member of a violent gang of teens, assaulted Father Philip Benizi, the Prior Servite General. After the assault, Father Philip prayed for and blessed the teens. The example of Father Philip's kindness and mercy moved Peregrine so profoundly, he said to Father Philip "I want what you have." Father Philip said to Peregrine come and join our way of life as a servant of Mary in the Servite Order. Peregrine served as Priest of the Servite Order for many years. Contracting cancer of the right leg at the age of 60 and preparing to have his leg amputated,. Peregrine prayed before a mural painting of a Crucifix. Falling asleep beneath the Cross, he had a vision of Jesus descending from the Cross and healing his leg. When Peregrine awoke his leg was healed. From that day forward many people, through his intercession, have received healing from cancer and other illnesses.

Let us pray: "O St. Peregrine, as you stand with Jesus, the Healer in Heaven, please mention our requests to our Good God for strength and energy to cope today with our illnesses, especially those suffering from cancer. Be our friend and companion on this journey. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen."
